Cruising Instructor Assessment



Three days, Solent based

In order to teach RYA Competent Crew , Helmsman or Day Skipper practical courses, instructors must hold a Yachtmaster (Offshore) certificate with a Cruising Instructor endorsement

Aim

A successful assessment will result in award of a Cruising Instructor endorsement for motor or sail by the RYA

Features

- The assessment will be performed as part of an RYA practical course with 'real' students, under the guidance of the Principal or Chief Instructor.
- Feedback will be provided on a regular basis throughout

Format

- The candidate is introduced over a two day period to a real teaching environment and will learn instructional techniques.
- A key part of the assessment is demonstrating your ability to instruct students in any part of the appropriate syllabi.
- The candidate is informed of the result at the conclusion of the activity

Yacht Handling Under Sail & Power



Two days, Solent based

Aim

To develop a deeper understanding of yacht handling characteristics resulting in more confidence to do the departing and arriving bits without embarrassment!

Features

- A 'no pressure' safe environment learn by 'doing and discussion' under the watchful eye of an RYA instructor
- You tell us which skills you want to develop
- Practise makes perfect the opportunities to do it, do it and do it again under expert guidance are few and far between!

Content

There is no fixed format for this activity as the emphasis may be adjusted to suit the needs of the participants. However the following are likely to be included as a minimum

- Effect of prop/keel configuration on yacht handling characteristics
- Coming alongside
- Pontoon moorings
- Reversing
- Turning in confined spaces under power
- Use of springs
- Mooring buoys and anchoring under power and sail and various combinations of wind and tide

ICC



Two¹ or three days

Aim

The aim of the course is to learn the boat handling and navigation skills necessary to qualify for an International Certificate of Competence – mandatory to skipper a Yacht, Motor Cruiser or Powerboat¹ in European waters.

Features

- The course consists of a written and practical assessment
- Contains theory and practical elements enabling a beginner to gain familiarity with basic motor cruising skills.
- Join us or use your own boat

NB ICCs are issued automatically to holders of RYA Day Skipper (Sail or Motor Cruising) or Level 2 (Powerboat) certificates. We recommend you consider this alternative qualifying route
